Parks Committee met on October 4, 2016 present was Craig Nelson, Kathy Fairchild, Lowell Phillips, Gene Stanton and Max Springer.

Discussion was held concerning budget request from City staff and Ball Leagues, High School Girls Softball

1. Trading in 2 Grasshopper mowers
2. New Concession Stand and restrooms
Discussed having putting some money in the budget for engineering fees for design and estimated cost.
3. Walkway around Williams Creek Pond
The walkway around part of the pond needs to be replaced due to damage caused by tree roots. Repair would be accomplished by replacing damaged asphalt with concrete over a period of 3 years doing 1/3 of the 10 foot walkway each year.
4. Re-lamping fields 3 & 4
We have several bulbs out on these fields because of the height of the poles we contract it out. The bulbs normally last about 5 years all of the bulbs will be replaced on these two fields.
5. Temporary fence for field #3 for Girls High School games
Discussion was held and all agreed to see if the School District would purchase the temporary fencing and we would install it.
6. Service road south of pool going to park maintenance building we would like to chip and seal

Also Discussed Skate Park and where we want to go with developing the Spirit of 76 Park. The Committee decided that we should do a survey by mail and or through the Record to find out what support there is for developing the Park, such as a bond issue and sales tax.
